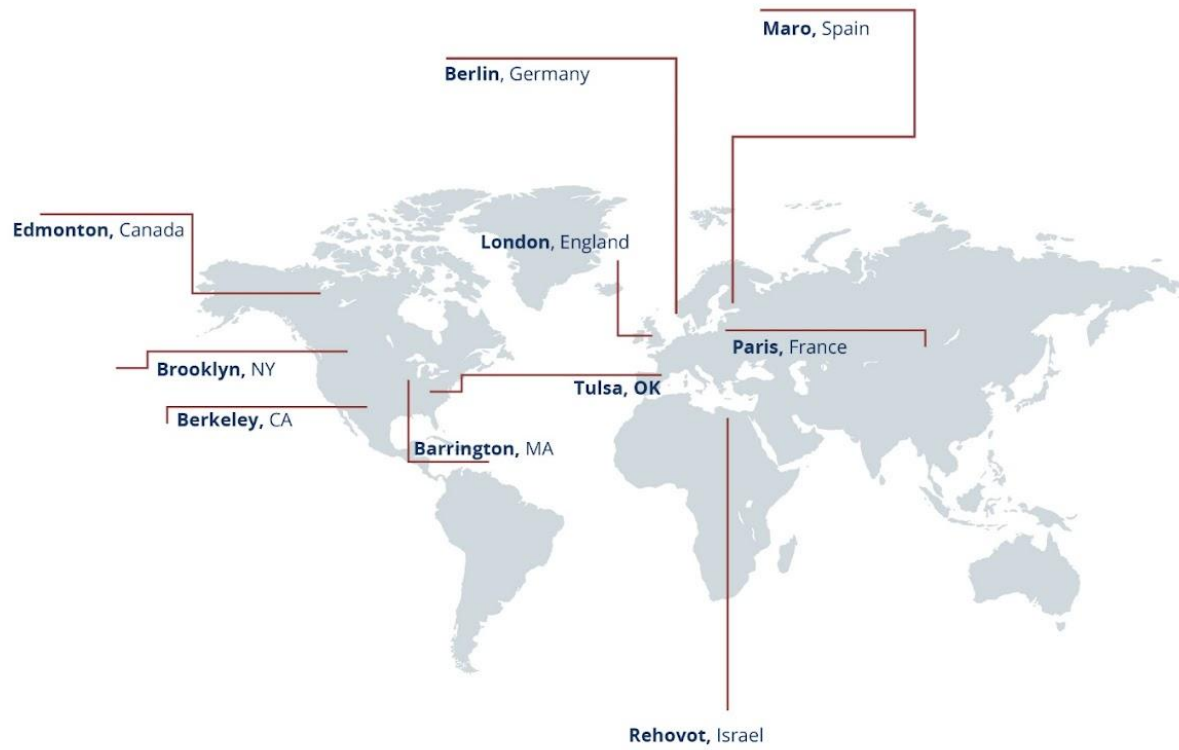


TO BE GRATEFUL

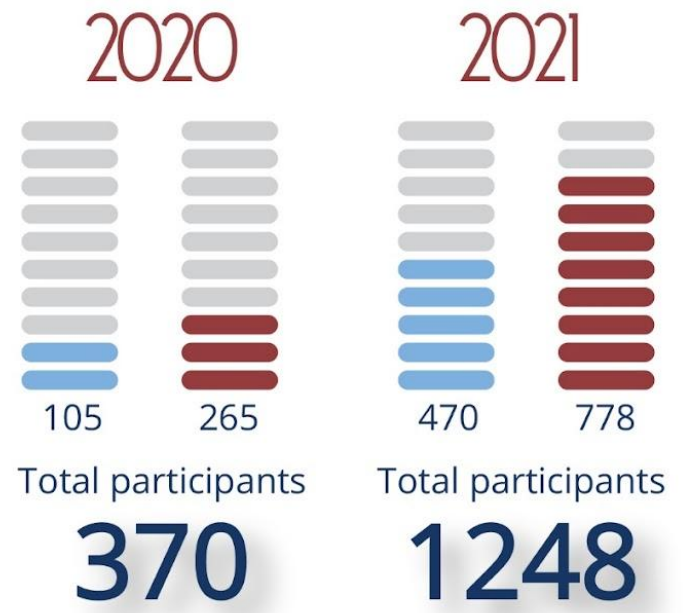

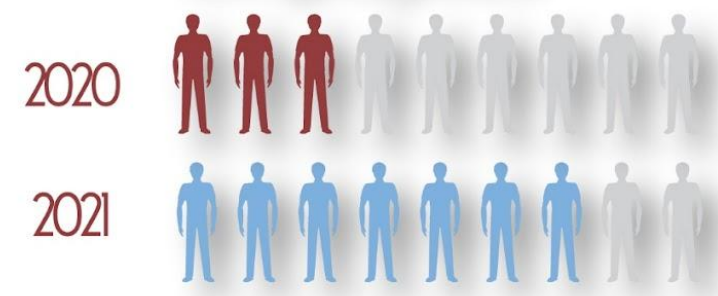
